



### 1: Introduction


Thank you for purchasing Orbita Hotel Door Lock E3042. The product is made of grade 304 stainless steel with a PVC card reader cover, with strong resistance to impact, corrosion and abrasion. The door lock PCB is waterproof with stable and reliable quality.

E3042 Door Lock can support other types of hotel management software, Fidelio/Opera, and Orbita wireless portable programmer for door lock setting, data collection and download functions. Certified by European CE and U.S. FCC, our products adopt the American standard 5-point tongue lock body with an anti-shim plunger design and an abnormal latch bolt alert for double security, stability and reliability. Functions such as door left open warning, low battery voltage warning, channel function and all-inone function are available.


E3042 Lock can be used in hotels, hospitals, schools and apartments, which comes with Orbita management system to save time and costs.

- Door types: Wooden, metal and composite doors





### Installation Steps


1. Please choose the correct door lock in accordance with the door swing direction


#### 2. Drill holes using the cardboard cutout provided





(Door plank)

3: Install the lock body and put the cylinder into it, and then fasten with screws




4: Fasten the front and rear panels with screws. Note that the holes in both panels should be aligned



5: Insert the side trim to the latch bolt hole and fasten with screws



6: Install the strike plate and side plate




7: After the installation, open the key cover on the front panel. Use the key to unlock the door and check whether the handle and double-lock features work properly. If the door does not unlock or the handle or double-lock does not function well, check whether the cylinder, the square shafts of the handle and the deadbolt knob are installed correctly.

8: If no issue is found during the above steps, please use the cards already set up to swipe at the display area of the front panel and check whether the door unlocks.

#### 3. Operation Guide

3-1: Unlock by card: Swipe the card and you will hear a beep with blue light lit up. Then press down the handle to unlock.



3-2: Lock from inside: Rotate the deadbolt knob on the rear panel f or the double lock function

(Note: The card needs to be encoded by the compatible management software and card encoder before use.

# 4. Daily Maintenance and Care

- Avoid contact with corrosive liquids as this may damage the plating of the lock.
- Do not hang heavy objects on the handle to protect it from dislocation or abrasion.
- Please replace the batteries in time when the battery voltage is low, and pay attention to its polarities.
- Use water and dry towels for cleaning. Do not use other corrosive cleaning agents.
- Please contact customer service for help if the lock body does not rotate smoothly. And do not disassemble it on your own.
- Please keep the keys in a safe place in case of an emergency.
- It is recommended to check the door lock once every six months or once a year to avoid the loose screws and handles affecting regular functions.

## 5. Troubleshooting

Problem: Two red blinks and two beeps indicate that either it is the guest card for other rooms, or the maintenance card has exceeded its specified number of times for unlocking.

Solution: Open the door with the correct guest card or reset the maintenance card.

Problem: Three red blinks and three beeps indicate that the valid time period of the card does not match the lock.

Solution: The guest card has expired, please issue a new card or update the lock's time.

Problem: Four red blinks and four beeps indicate that the card has not been authorized.

Solution: Authorize the card with a setting card.

Problem: Five red blinks and five beeps indicate that the card has been suspended.

Solution: If the card has been suspended, it cannot be used. Please use a new card.

Problem: Six red blinks and six beeps indicate that the door has been double-locked.

Solution: A double-locked door can only be opened by the correct guest card and a master card.

Problem: Seven red blinks and seven beeps indicate that the lock has been restricted for opening by a restriction card.

Solution: The lock can only open with an additional reading of a master card or a restriction card.

Problem: Eight red blinks and eight beeps indicate that the lock has been authorized by a setting card from other systems.

Solution: If the password is unknown, the only solution is to perform compulsory authorization for the lock.
